The Intent and important aspects of this Expression of Interest is (EOI) are as follows:-

(a) BECIL is interested to submit a competitive bid in response to the Client **Tender Number: GeM Number: GeM Number: GEM/2024/B/5332912** **Dated: 27-08-2024** **having Last date of submission as 18-09-2024 11:00:00** floated by "Central University of Tamilnadu Thiruvapur".

(b) The intent of this EOI is to select an Implementation Agency/ System Integrator / Back end Technology partner of BECIL, for collaborating with BECIL for preparing a bid and participating in the above mentioned tender. BECIL will issue a Work Order/Agreement to the selected agency. In such a scenario, the following conditions will be applicable, which are to be fully taken into consideration by the bidders, prior submitting a response to this EOI:-

Supporting documents if in a language other than English must be accompanied by a English translated document. The English version shall prevail in matters of interpretation. - 2.3 In case only one bid is received or during the Technical Evaluation only one OEM/Authorized Supplier/Agency/Partner qualified, BECIL reserves the right to accept/reject the bid.

## 3. EVALUATION PROCESS

- 3.1 No enquiry shall be made by the bidder/ Agency (s) during the course of evaluation of the EOI, after opening of bid, till final decision is conveyed to the successful OEM/Authorized/Supplier/Agency/Partner. However, the Evaluation Committee/its authorized representative and office of BECIL can make any enquiry/seek clarification from the OEM/Authorized Supplier/Agency/Partner, which the OEM/Authorized Supplier/Agency/Partner must furnish within the stipulated time else the bids of such defaulting OEM/Authorized Supplier/Agency/Partner will be rejected. The proposal will be evaluated on the basis of its content, not its length.
- 3.2 OEM/Authorized Supplier/Agency/Partner proposals will be evaluated as per the requirements specified in the EOI and adopting the evaluation criteria spelt out in subsequent paras of this EOI document.
